**A LAW TO REPEAL AND RE-ENACT THE ILORIN TOWNSHIP (PROHIBITION AGAINST THE MANUFACTURE, SALE AND CONSUMPTION OF LIQUOR IN CERTAIN AREAS) LAW, CAP. I2, TO EXPAND THE LIQUOR PROHIBITED AREAS IN ILORIN METROPOLIS**

Date of Commencement.

The Kwara State House of Assembly enacts:

1. No person shall produce or sell, or openly consume, any liquor within the areas of Ilorin metropolis specified in the Schedule to this Law.

Prohibition against production, sale or consumption of liquor.

2. A Police officer may –

- (a) for the purpose of conducting a search, enter any premises in which he has reasonable grounds for believing that liquor is being produced, sold, or stored for the purpose of sale;
- (b) seize and detain any liquor, together with the receptacle used in keeping it, found either on the premises occupied by, or in the possession of, or under the control of any person whom he has reasonable grounds for suspecting of having produced, sold, or stored such liquor.

Power to search premises.

3. A court may order the forfeiture of any liquor or any implement used in the commission of an offence under this Law to the Kwara State Government.

Forfeiture.

4. Any person who contravenes the provision of section 1 shall be guilty of an offence and liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding ₦100,000 or imprisonment for a term not exceeding six months or both.

Penalty.

5. The provisions of this Law shall not apply to any premises in respect of which a licence or permit is issued to sell liquor under the Liquor Law or a local government by-law.

Exemptions.

6. In this Law –

Interpretation.

“liquor” means any liquid which, if used as a beverage, may have an intoxicating effect and includes wine, beer, spirits, and home-brewed or local liquor;

“State” means the Kwara State of Nigeria.

7. The Ilorin Township (Prohibition against the Manufacture, Sale and Consumption of Liquor in Certain Areas) Law, Cap. I2 of the Laws of Kwara State is repealed.

Repeal of Cap. I2.

8. This Bill may be cited as the Ilorin Township (Prohibition against the Production, Sale and Consumption of Liquor in Certain Areas) Bill, 2017.

## SCHEDULE

## (SECTION 1)

### LIQUOR PROHIBITED AREAS IN ILORIN

1. From Central Mosque through Emir’s Road terminating at Aluko Bridge.
2. Gambari Road and Ojagboro.
3. Shao Road, Karuma Road, Isale Koko and Okesuna.
4. Ajanaku, Edun, Isale Koko, Sakama, Asunnara and Isale Maliki.
5. Abdul Azeez Atta Road from the Central Mosque terminating at Aluko Stream, Alapata, Agaka-Oke, Agaka Isale, Eruda, Gegele, Fagba and Ehinkule-Oba.
6. From Government High School roundabout through Kuntu Popo Omo-Oba, Isale Aluko, Jaji Street, Alanamu and Ita-Oloko-Nla.
7. Dada, Alawo-Nla, Ondoko, Kankatu, Isale Elesin and Okelele.
8. From Isale-Oja to Pakata roundabout, Oke-Ebo Alaso, Ita-Nma and Oke-Anifowose.
9. From Idi-Ape Jumat Mosque through Alimi Road, Omoda and terminating at Fooma Stream.
10. From Government High School roundabout through Oke Agodi, Idigba, Oke-Anifowose terminating at Oloje
11. From Old Yidi Road Junction through Ita Amadu to Niger Road/ Emir’s Road junction.
12. From Niger Road junction to Isale-Oja roundabout through Abdulazeez Attah Road, Nasfat village, to National Youth Centre.

13. From Gerin Alimi roundabout through Asa Dam Road (including Joro village) and turning at Harmony Diagnostic Centre junction, through New Yidi Road to the junction with Wahab Folawiyo Road (formerly Unity Road).
14. From New Yidi Road/Wahab Folawiyo Road junction through Taiwo Isale and part of Emir's Road to Aluko bridge before Edun Road junction.
15. From Edun Road junction through Opo-malu Road to Amilegbe terminating at Amilegbe bridge.
16. From Amilegbe bridge through Ipata to Gambari Road/Sobi Road junction to Alagbado terminating at Kwara State Specialist Hospital junction.
17. From the Kwara State Specialist Hospital junction through Alagbado area to Medina and terminating at Oko-Olowo.
18. From Harmony Housing Estate junction to Zango junction (including areas on both sides of the road).
19. From Sabo-Oke junction through Old Jebba Road and terminating at Oke-Oyun bridge.
20. From Pakata roundabout to Alore junction (including Omoda, Oloje and Banni).
21. From Adeta roundabout to Yebumot Hotel through Kwara State Muslim Pilgrims Board office, Islamic village, Gerehu, Doodu, Warah village and terminating at Gaa Odota
22. From Government High School Adeta through Sheikh Adam Road to Oke Anifowose and Oloje terminating at Oko-Olowo.
23. From Gerin Alimi roundabout through the ultra-modern market and terminating at Yebumot Hotel roundabout.
24. From Pakata roundabout to Ita Nma through Gaa-Saka and Madi terminating at the highway linking Oko-Olowo.
25. From Pakata roundabout to Omoda roundabout (including Idiape).
26. From Surulere/Agbo-Oba Road junction to Adeta roundabout.
